### By train

Essen Hbf. (central station), take S-Bahn S6, direction Köln-Hansaring (Cologne) until Bf. Essen-Werden, here Bus-line 190 direction „Ruhr-Klinik“ leave at Stop (Haltestelle) „Am Turm“

## By car

**Navigation:** Am Turm 7, 45239 Essen

### from the south and west via Köln/ Düsseldorf

Highway A3, at crossing "Autobahnkreuz Breitscheid", change to highway A 52, direction Essen, until Exit „Ausfahrt Essen-Rüttenscheid“, turn right on B 224, direction Vellbert/Wuppertal, follow until Essen-Werden, then ....

### from north and east via Münster/Dortmund

Highway A 40 up to „Autobahnkreuz Essen- Ost“, change to A 52, direction Düsseldorf, 3 km leave at Exit „Ausfahrt Essen-Rüttenscheid“, turn left on B 224 direction Vellbert/Wuppertal up to Essen-Werden, then.....

### Small MEEPs/ cars

After big Ruhr bridge in Werden at right hand, follow information sign "Haus am Turm" or DJH (Youth hostel) „Jugendherberge“, follow narrow streets running uphill, pass DJH youth hostel, turn right to „Haus am Turm“; Parking ground behind gate barrier.

### Large Mobiles/ buses

After big Ruhr bridge in Werden stay on B 224 for 3 km, running up the hill, until bus stop „Heidhauser Platz“, turn right on Jacobs allee, follow for 1 km, at t-junction turn left on Barkhoven Allee, follow street until small road „Am Turm“; Parking ground behind the gate barrier.
