- A water cycle station (with dramatic role play scenarios and costumes)
- A soils research station (with live earthworms)
- An integrated pest management station (with interactive role play and insect puppets)
- A musical and dramatic wrap-up designed to reinforce the learning
- Comprehensive teacher packet complete with pre and post "Green Machine" activities

These in-class lessons help your students understand where their food comes from.

Who is it for?

Classrooms of Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 4th graders. There will be 4 separate 1 hour classes per day for 4 different groups of students.

A Visit to Bell Gardens. This real working farm is owned by Glen W. Bell, Jr., retired founder of Taco Bell. Your students will experience an educational, hands-on four of local agriculture.
